The WCPF was established as a UK registered charity in 1997 to raise funds to protect the critically endangered wild Bactrian camel in its habitat in north-west China and Mongolia. There are approximately 900 left in the world and it is more endangered than the giant Panda. It was listed in 2007 as the eighth most endangered large mammal and in 2008 was confirmed as a NEW and SEPARATE species. The WCPF has established with the Chinese government the 155,000 square kilometre Lop Nur Wild Camel National Nature Reserve in the Gobi desert. In Mongolia, the WCPF has established a successful captive wild Bactrian camel breeding programme. Jane Goodall DBE is the patron of the WCPF.
